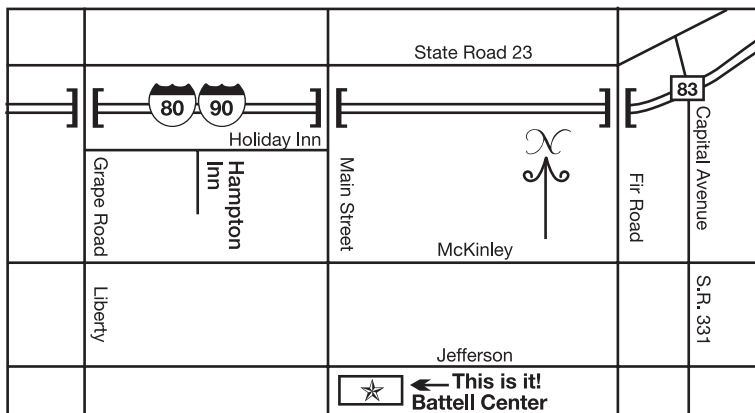

Directions to Hotel and Battell Center:

From 80/90: Exit Mishawaka Exit #83, follow to S.R. 23, turn left and follow to Main Street/ Gumwood Road. Turn left (south) onto Main.

To Hotel: Continue to first light – turn right, past the Time Square shopping plaza on left.

To Battell Center: South on Main to 904 N. Main (school building on left).

From U.S. 31 South: Travel north to U.S. 30, go east to Bremen Hwy. From Bremen Hwy, go north (Bremen Hwy. becomes Main Street in Mishawaka). As you cross the river, Battell Center is 2 lights north.



Ranya Renée of New York City

Ranya teaches Middle Eastern dance in New York City and in workshops internationally, with an orientation towards Egyptian-style dance. Her teaching method focuses on healthy posture, breathing and Pilates-influenced muscular technique, melodic and rhythmic interpretation, and creative performance skills. She offers regular classes, and coaches some of New York's top professionals as well as ambitious beginners just starting out. As a teacher, she encourages students to reach their highest potential in both physicality and artistic expression.

On Saturday, Ranya will teach "Egyptian to the Core" body philosophy, influenced by Pilates-based core abdominal work. This technique works with postural and muscular connections in the body for a healthy, centered, grounded way of dancing. She will continue with "Technique Tidbits for Egyptian Orientale Dance", working with some of her favorite combinations, and focus on the technique of "movement linking" to create a smooth flow between distinct movements, as well as applying breathwork to the combinations for a more relaxed look and feel. Differences between Classical Golden Age and Modern styling will be addressed. We will also explore how to embrace your mistakes and transform them into opportunities for an even more

interesting and personal performance! Be sure to bring your veils.

On Sunday, the Master Class will focus on Andalusian lyrical rhythms and steps, utilizing the Semai Thaqil (10/8 rhythm). You will gain an appreciation of a more lyrical approach to working with rhythm.

Sunday's Master Class, "Lyrical Combos for Semai Rhythm" — More than a thousand years ago, the Arabs established an empire in southern Spain, Al-Andalus. There was a great flourishing of artistic, literary, and musical culture, including lyrical poetry set to music, composed in a diverse array of rhythms. We'll work with the most famous, the 10-count semai thaqil, to become familiar with interpreting the beats of this rhythm as dancers and applying the rhythm to dance in a variety of contexts, from Andalusian "muwashahat" pieces to drum solo interludes. We'll use Mahmoud Reda combinations and those inspired by his work to gain facility with dancing fluidly to the rhythm as well as how to accent the beats. Ranya will also show examples from other lyrical rhythms to open up a world of expressive possibilities for serious dancers.
